Follow the joyful sounds through the colorful entrances into a vibrant environment that blurs the lines between audience and performers. The public is invited to walk through or play upon a feast of handmade musical instruments led by a series of experimental sound and performance artists. All ages are welcome!

In addition, there will be other participatory venues, such as creating sound makers from scratch. Large boards will also be available for drawing and sharing thoughts and ideas on creating community.
