

Net art, also known as internet art, is not clearly defined but a main characteristic is the artwork must be distributed through the internet. Net art works often draw on data from other Internet materials and websites, which helps give them their distinctive dynamics and transience. The medium itself is the art work unlike a clear medium you would find within a painting or a photograph. Net art is not simply just

taking a piece of art work, digitalizing it, and making it available to view on the internet. Net art relies intrinsically on the internet to exist- it refers to the internet as a whole.
